Literacy- we will be covering a wide range of text types including information books, poems and letters. We will still be having a large focus on handwriting, phonics and our sentence structure (capital letters, finger spaces and using and to join ideas.) This will all be within the context of our topic; Homes and the Great Fire of London.

History - our topic is the Great Fire of London, we will be looking at how it started and why it is a significant event in history. We will also be comparing how houses have changed over time.

Music-We will be learning how to compare songs as well as doing a variety of vocal warm up activities.

Maths-We will be looking at place value. This will include ordering and comparing numbers to 50. We will move on to multiplication by counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. Finally we will be focussing on length and height and weight and volume, understanding what this language means and comparing different amounts.

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'The great fire of London'

Science- we will be continuing with our topic of materials. We will be looking at what different objects are made out of. We will also be describing these materials using the properties.

Art/DT - we will be using collage and paint to create scenes from the Great Fire of London and different resources to create the houses and boats.

In PE we will be studying dance, We will be making up our own dance routines using creative shapes and movements.

R.E- we will be covering the theme of Salvation. We will be looking at the celebration of Easter and new life.
