As part of our History unit, we are learning about Prehistoric Britain and life in the Stone Age. To support the year 6 understanding of this topic, we are going on a school visit to Creswell Crags Museum on **Friday 7th June 2024**. During the visit the children will learn about the life of our ice age ancestors; the creatures of this era and the survival skills needed during these periods.
