Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our History learning about the Stone Age, we have booked Y3 on a visit to The Discovery Centre at Ecclesall Woods to take part in a Stone Age workshop. The children will take part in a day full of immersive and engaging activities including den building, fire lighting, learning about Stone Age tribes, practising hunting strategies and playing games to encourage teamwork.

This visit will take place on <u>Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February</u> 10am-2pm. We will be catching the bus so need to leave school at 8.50am promptly. We will be returning back to school on time for the normal 3.15pm pick up. As we are there all day, the children will require a packed lunch (unless your child is free school meals) and will need to wear warm clothing and sensible footwear due to most of the activities taking place outdoors.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10, to help cover the cost of the activities. This includes bus fare to and from the venue. Although your contribution is entirely voluntary, you will appreciate that the visit will only go ahead if there are sufficient contributions to cover the costs of the visit. Activities such as this are beneficial because they give pupils experiences they may not otherwise have and this impacts positively on their learning and progress. Payment is to be made via Parent Pay - if you have not yet signed up, please contact the office and you will be able to pay by card over the phone.
